EISENHOWER BLUE GOLF COURSE

One of the most popular sites at the Academy is the golf club. A modern scenic facility with two 18-hole courses: the championship Blue, and the stunning Silver. The Eisenhower Golf Club, named after U.S. President Dwight Eisenhower, is the golf course located on the grounds of the United States Air Force Academy, just north of Colorado Springs. Named the top golf course in the Department of Defense by Travel and Leisure Golf magazine, the course is a member of USA Today's Top 100 courses in the nation. Eisenhower is also the home course for the Academy's perennial league champion intercollegiate golf team. The clubhouse features Ike's Grill, the Eisenhower Room, the Pro Shop and locker rooms. Golf clubs, power and hand carts are available to rent from the Pro Shop.

Blue Golf Course The 18-hole Blue Course features 7,301 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72 [300 yards from the championship tees, 6,516 from the regular tees and 5,559 from the forward tees]. The course rating is 74.2 and it has a slope rating of 137. Designed by Robert Trent Jones, ASGCA, the Blue Course opened in 1959.

POLICIES / DRESS STANDARDS

Men:

- Shirts must have collars and sleeves
- Mock turtlenecks and turtlenecks are acceptable
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length
- Shorts or slacks must be hemmed
- Only soft spiked golf shoes, smooth-soled tennis shoes or sneakers allowed

Women:

- Sleeveless tops must have 3" shoulders
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length
- Only soft spiked golf shoes or smooth-soled tennis shoes are allowed

Not Allowed:

- T-shirts and muscle shirts
- Sandals (unless they are golf sandals)
- Uniforms and uniform pants
- Cut-off shorts
- Short shorts
- Frayed shorts and pants
- Athletic or gym shorts and pants
- Swim Suits
- Halter Tops
- Midriff Baring tops
- Undershirts
- Tank Tops
- Apparel with obscene , profane, or abusive designs or messages

Directions: Follow I-25 S to Northgate Blvd. Take exit 156. Take Exit 156 toward N Entrance/Air Force Academy. Continue on Northgate Blvd to Entrance USAF Academy. Continue through Gate on Northgate Blvd (Will require ID to enter, no exceptions). Turn left onto Stadium Blvd. Turn right onto Parade Loop. Turn left to Eisenhower Golf Course.
